

JEFFERSON COUNTY SPORTSMEN'S CLUB

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES:

1. Each membership consists of the primary member and, if applicable, spouse/partner, and/or children in household under the age of 18. If full-time student, up to age 21.
2. Giving the gate code and or the combination to the ranges to non-members will be grounds for revoking your membership.
3. Club members must have their membership card with them and vehicle window sticker clearly visible while on the club property.
4. Guests must be with a current member in good standing. Members may bring -2- guests for a total of two visits maximum per guest. Each guest must pay a **Guest Fee of \$4.72 plus 6% sales tax of .28 cents for a total of \$5.00.**
5. Violations of club rules or regulations by a member including spouse/partner, child/children, or guest(s) may be cause for revoking membership and subject to review by the board of directors.
6. All children under 18 years of age must be under the supervision of a parent or club member.
7. All WILDLIFE on club property is PROTECTED, with exception of club sponsored and managed bow hunts.
8. Excessive drinking and foul language will not be allowed.
9. Anyone destroying club property will be responsible for the cost of the damage and his or her membership may be revoked.
10. Vehicle speed on club property is 10 MPH. Traffic is confined to the roads only, no off-road driving.
11. Using the dumpster for outside trash is a violation of club rules.
12. Concealed Carry Classes are held the third Saturday of each month, NO EXEPTIONS.
13. No fish cleaning anywhere on club property.

CLUB GROUNDS AND BUILDINGS:

14. Restrooms are in the indoor archery range and are open 24 hours.
15. Primitive camping is allowed in designated camping areas only. You must have a reservation for camping by calling (502) 821-4440. Tent and RV's are allowed. Dumping of waste is NOT allowed.
16. Open fires are prohibited. Fires are allowed in the camping areas only and must be contained in grills or approved fire rings. Fires should be attended to always.

LAKES, FISHING AND BOATS:

17. NO swimming, wading or ice skating at any time allowed.
18. Fishing is allowed on the main lake and the pond to the left of the pistol range. Fishing is not allowed on right side of the pond.
19. A Kentucky Fishing License IS REQUIRED.
20. Kentucky Fish and Wildlife creel limits apply except largemouth bass have a 15-inch limit and there is a 4 catfish per day limit (FLATHEAD CATFISH CANNOT BE TAKEN, AND MUST BE RELEASED) or as otherwise posted.
21. Bow fishing for carp IS ALLOWED.
22. Frogging and noodling are prohibited.
23. Non-gasoline boats are allowed on main lake, including *electric trolling motorboats*. GAS ENGINE BOATS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
24. Unused bait is **not** to be discarded into lake.
25. Trot lines or other unattended lines are not allowed.
26. There is a 2-pole per person limit.
27. No boats on lake between 10:00pm and 6:00am.

TRAP, PISTOL, .22 RIFLE AND BLACK POWDER RANGES:

28. Eye and ear protection are REQUIRED on all ranges.
29. Consuming alcoholic beverages before or while shooting is prohibited.
30. Anyone acting or shooting in an unsafe manner will be asked to leave immediately.
31. Range Officers will be responsible and in charge of all ranges.
32. You must become a RANGE OFFICER to use the pistol, .22 or black powder range unsupervised.
33. Members and guests are required to follow all safety rules posted on each range.
34. Hours of operation are posted on each range.
35. No Deer slugs allowed on any range.
36. Range Officer Identification must be worn when shooting on all ranges except for Trap.
37. Trap Range is ONLY open on Sundays and begins at 1:00pm. Only 7 ½ shot or smaller.

ARCHERY RANGE:

38. The outdoor archery range is open during normal hours for practice.
39. The indoor archery range hours are posted and vary according to the time of year.
40. Always shoot in a safe manner. Anyone acting or shooting in an unsafe manner will be asked to leave the club
