# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

# **GENERAL RULES:**

- 1. Each membership consists of the primary member and, if applicable, the spouse/partner and/or any children under the age of 18 and, if full-time student, up to age 21.
- 2. Giving the gate code and or the combination to the ranges to non-members will be grounds for revoking your membership.
- 3. Club members must have their membership card with them and vehicle window sticker clearly visible while on the club property.
- 4. Guests must be with a current member in good standing. Members may bring 2 guests for a total of two visits maximum per guest. All guests must pay a \$5.00 fee.
- 5. Violations of club rules or regulations by a member including spouse/partner, their child/children or guest(s) may be cause for revoking their membership and reviewed by the board of directors.
- 6. All children under 18 years of age must be under the supervision of a parent or club member.
- 7. Excessive drinking and foul language will not be allowed.
- 8. Anyone destroying club property will be responsible for the cost of the damage and his or her membership may be revoked.
- 9. Vehicle speed on club property is 10 MPH. Traffic is confined to the roads only, no off-road driving.
- **10.** Using the dumpster for outside trash is a violation of club rules.
- 11. Concealed Carry Classes are held the third Saturday of each month, NO EXEPTIONS.
- **12.** No fish cleaning anywhere on club property.

# **CLUB GROUNDS AND BUILDINGS:**

- 13. Restrooms are in the indoor archery range and are open 24 hours.
- 14. Primitive camping is allowed in designated camping areas only. You must have a reservation for camping by calling (502) 821-4440. Tent and RVs are allowed. Dumping of waste is not allowed.
- **15.** Open fires are prohibited. Fires are allowed in the camping areas only and must be contained in grills or approved fire rings. Fires should be tended to always.

### LAKES, FISHING and BOATS:

- 16. NO swimming, wading or ice skating at any time allowed.
- 17. Fishing is allowed in the main lake and the pond to the left of the pistol range.
- **18.** A Kentucky Fishing License IS REQUIRED.
- 19. Kentucky Fish and Wildlife creel limits apply except largemouth bass have a 15-inch limit and there is a 4 catfish per day limit.
- **20.** Frogging and noodling are prohibited.
- 21. Boats are allowed on main lake with *electric trolling motors only*. GAS ENGINES ON BOATS ARE NOT ALLOWED.
- **22.** Unused bait is not to be discarded into lake.
- **23.** Trot lines or other unattended lines are not allowed.
- **24.** There is a 2-pole per person limit.
- **25.** No boats on lake between 10:00pm and 6:00am.

#### TRAP, PISTOL, .22 RIFLE RANGE and BLACK POWDER RANGES:

- 26. Eye and ear protection is REQUIRED on all ranges.
- 27. Consuming alcoholic beverages before or while shooting is prohibited.
- 28. Anyone acting or shooting in an unsafe manner will be asked to leave immediately.
- **29.** Range Officers will be responsible and in charge of all ranges.
- 30. You must become a range officer to use the pistol, .22 or black powder range unsupervised.
- **31.** Members and guest must follow all safety rules posted on each range.
- **32.** Hours of operation are posted on each range.
- **33.** No Deer slugs allowed on any range.
- 34. Concealed Carry Classes are held the third Saturday of each month and any other training must be approved by the board.
- **35.** Only  $7\frac{1}{2}$  shot or smaller may be used on the trap range.
- 36. Range Officer Identification must be worn when shooting on all ranges except for Trap.
- **37.** Trap Range is open every Sunday at 1:00PM.

#### **ARCHERY RANGE:**

- **38.** The outdoor archery range is open during normal hours for practice.
- **39.** The indoor archery range is open from 9AM till 9PM daily.
- 40. Shoot in a safe manner always. Anyone acting or shooting in an unsafe manner will be asked to leave the club.
- **41.** Bow fishing for carp IS ALLOWED.
